

Recess Winter Clothing Guidelines

The guidelines for proper winter wear vary from level to level depending upon the needs of the children. Please be sure that children come prepared for outside recess. Remember that Minnesota weather is variable; children should come prepared for the worst every day! **All clothes should be labeled.**

Children's House

Children should come to school every day with: warm coat, snow pants, warm hat, gloves or mittens, scarf, and snow boots.

Elementary I

<i>Temperature / Weather Conditions</i>	<i>Clothing required / information</i>
warm days, below 50° F	jacket, hat
soggy, wet conditions	boots, coat, hat
definite rain	stay inside
snowy or cold (below 32° F)	boots, snow pants, hat, coat, gloves
below -10° F (including wind chill)	stay inside

Elementary II

<i>Temperature / Weather Conditions</i>	<i>Clothing required / information</i>
warm days, below 50° F	jacket
soggy, wet, or mucky conditions	boots necessary
definite rain	stay inside
below 32° F but not snowy or wet	hat, coat, gloves needed (snow pants and boots are optional)
below 32° F with snow	boots, hat, coat, gloves (snow pants required if the temperature is below 20° F)
below -15° F (including wind chill)	stay inside

Junior High

If the temperature is 32° F or below, coat, hat and gloves are required.
